

**THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY**

**BY-LAW NO. 2005-145**

**BEING A BY-LAW TO AMEND TRAFFIC & PARKING BY-LAW NO. 2002-001  
SCHEDULE 18 (NO PARKING AREAS AT ANY TIME)**

**WHEREAS** the *Municipal Act, 2001*, (S.O. 2001, c.25) authorizes the Council to pass By-laws regulating or prohibiting certain traffic on highways and regulating or prohibiting parking on highways;

**AND WHEREAS** the *Highway Traffic Act*, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter H-8, as amended, authorizes the Council to pass By-laws regulating traffic on highways;

**AND WHEREAS** the amendment to Schedule 18 (No Parking Areas At Any Time) was authorized by Resolution No. 2005-450 passed by Council at its Regular Meeting held on Monday, June 20, 2005.

**NOW, THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. That Schedule 18 to Traffic & Parking By-law No. 2002-001 is hereby amended by adding the following:

<u>Road</u>	<u>Side</u>	<u>From</u>	<u>To</u>
<b><u>SECTION "F"</u></b>			
"Fourth Avenue	south	Fraser Street	a point 100 metres east of Fraser Street
Fraser Street	west	Fourth Avenue	Fifth Avenue"

2. That this by-law comes into effect upon being passed.

READ A SECOND TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THIS 11<sup>TH</sup> DAY OF JULY, 2005.
